

Paint $Flex^{\mathbb{R}}$

How to Apply on the RotoPE Plastic Products





Step B01:

Please prepare Roto-Plastic Product for painting. You can take the best result on the Pin Holes Free Roto Product. (recommend using HW[®] PE Powder)

Why HW® PE Powder

- a. It does not request release agent into any kind of mould (Steel / Aluminum etc. ...).
- b. You can take Pin Hole free products under almost of all condition.
- c. It is very good compatibility between made from HW[®] PE Powder products and PaintFlex[®] Paint.

Step B02:

Clean the Roto-Plastic Product up Step B02.01

If you use release agent inside of Mould when you made your products, we recommend clean up by sanding #600~800, and, go to Step B02.02.
If not, Skip "Step B02.01", go to Step B02.02.





Step B02.02

Wipe off oil and dirt on the Products-> Cleaning by:

- \checkmark Toluene (Before go to Step 03, you do not need to wait.) or
- ✓ Acetone (Before go to Step 03, please wait 10 Mins or more)

Step B03: Paint 1st Layer <u>Max. 3 Bar (Very important)</u> Nozzle 0.8 ~ 1.1mm

Very Light Smoke (Most of time, you can not see the colour of PaintFlex[®].)

Note:

We used PaintFlex[®] Classic Green Colour.

1st Layer Paint Finish→







Step B04: Wait minimum 10minutes



Step B05: Paint 2nd Layer <u>Max. 3 Bar (Very important)</u> Nozzle 0.8 ~ 1.1mm Light Smoke (You can see the colour of PaintFlex[®].)









Step B06: Wait minimum 10minutes



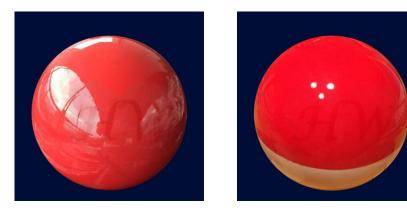
Step B07: (Optional) Paint 3rd Layer <u>Max. 3 Bar (Very important)</u> Nozzle 0.8 ~ 1.1mm Smoke

3rd Layer Paint Finish→





Step B08: (If you wish,)
 After 2 hours and more, you can
 ✓ Painting Lacquer or
 ✓ Painting Other Paint or
 ✓ Graphic Work or
 ✓ Affixing or
 ✓ etc...

Do not forget: PaintFlex[®] does not have pot life After painting, please store the remaining diluted paint included inside of spray gun into storage-can. You can use it, when you need....
